



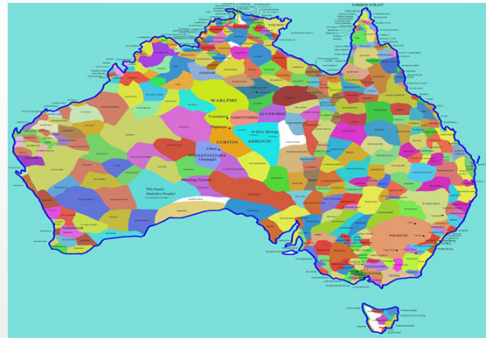

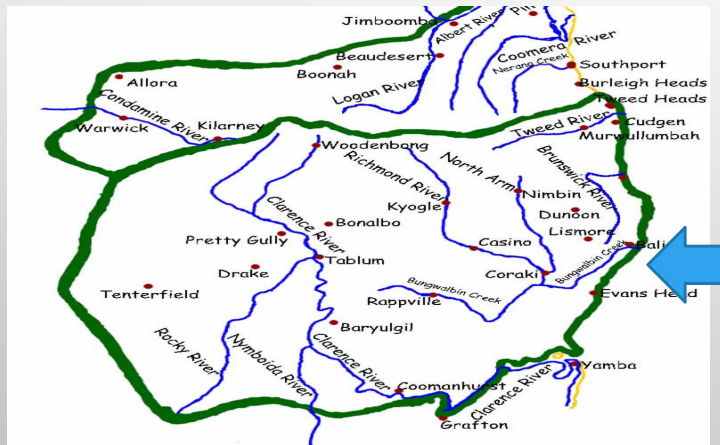

- 1893 school opened
- 16 massacre sites
- Cabbo set up as a safe haven
- Aboriginal children excluded from public schools
- Community set up out of town
- Assimilation and segregation
- Basic education

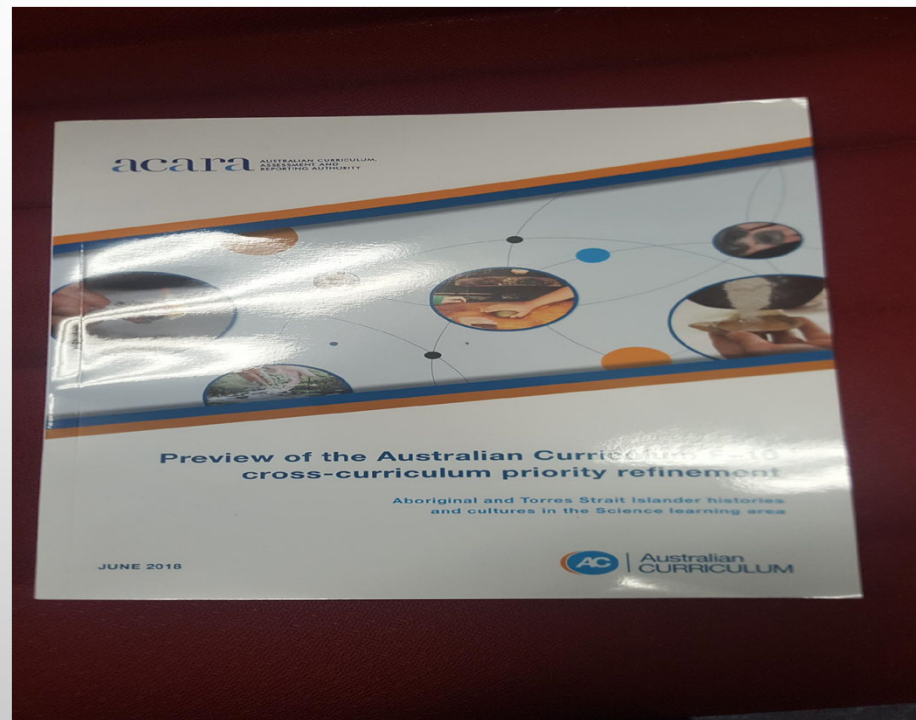
THE RACISM OF OMISSION

STATISTICS

- 2012 1.2% ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER TEACHERS IN AUSTRALIAN SCHOOLS WELL BELOW THE ABS ESTIMATE OF 3% FOR THE PROPORTION OF ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE IN THE AUSTRALIAN POPULATION
- AT THE SAME TIME ABORIGINAL STUDENTS FORMED 4.9% OF ALL STUDENTS IN AUSTRALIAN SCHOOLS
- 2015 3,100 ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER TEACHERS
- 2016 1165 ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER TEACHERS IN NSW DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION





RELEVANCE TO NSW

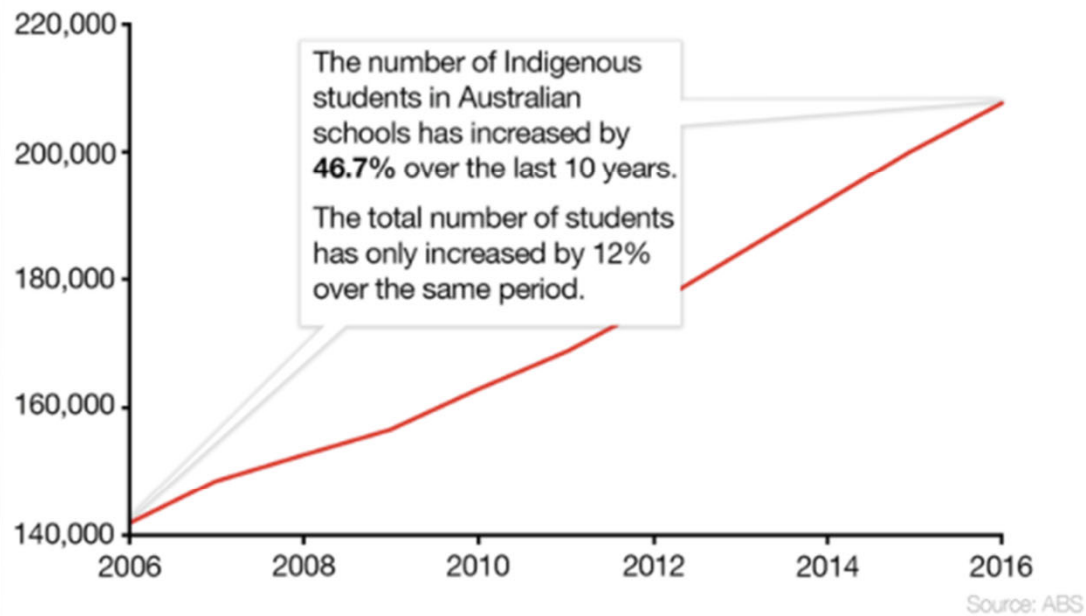
- 200, 563 + ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER STUDENTS
 - 32% OF ALL ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER STUDENTS RESIDE IN NSW
 - 5.5 % WITHIN NSW SCHOOLS
 - 84% IN GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS

The state of Indigenous education

While Indigenous students made up only 5.5% (1 in 20) of students in Australian schools in 2016, the number of Indigenous Australian students is rising much quicker than the overall population.
